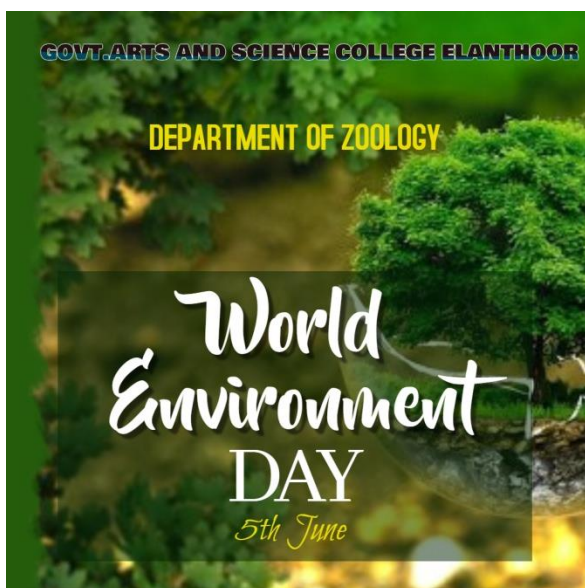

Official Inauguration Bhoomithrasena and Distribution of Vegetable Seed On 26.07.2019

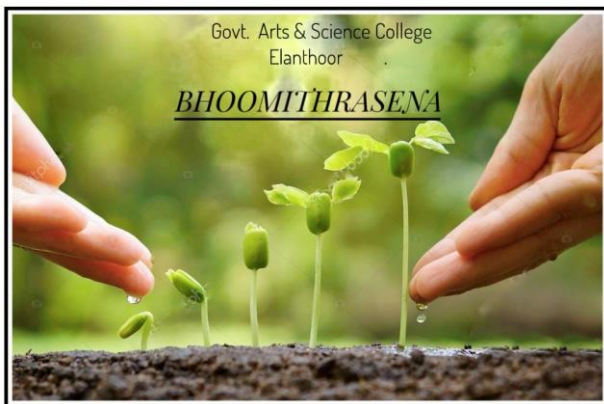
