The formal inauguration of 'Vegetable Garden was done on 22.07.2022 in association with 'njangalum krishiyilekku' scheme of Krishibhavan Elanthoor. The programme was inaugurated by ward member Smt. Indira E A.Dr. Shylalaja Kumari P A Principal, Government Arts and Science College Elanthoor. Mr. Aji, Agricultural Assistant, Krishibhavan Elanthoor has delivered a talk on the importance of organic Farming. He explained the necessity of organic vegetable garden and he shared some techniques for pest control using organic materials to the students. Krishibhavan provided 20 grow bag and seedlings. Vote of thanks was delivered by Smt. Hayarnnisa M, Coordinator of this programme.

20 students selected from different departments as nature club members. We prefer to take students from second year degree course because they were registered for an organic farming MOOC course of MG University. They planted vegetables like tomato, chilly, lady's finger, Brinjal and long beans as a startup initiative. We purchased 30 plant pots to setup vegetable garden due to the lack of own property and limited space. A small amount of area in our front backyard was used to plant the seedling in grow bags and pots. bag. The basal (organic fertilizers) used here was cow dung powder which is rich in natural nutrients. e. This increases the biological fertility and concentration of minerals. This was done for all the plants in grow bags. After 30 days, the stems of the tomatoes were attached to a separate stick to hold the tender stems. Now all the first planted vegetables are ready to be harvested. Students have developed a good attitude towards agriculture.
